



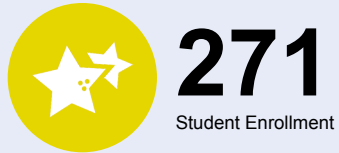

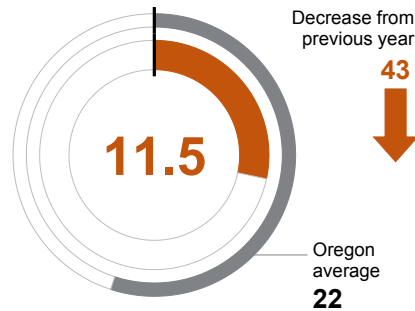

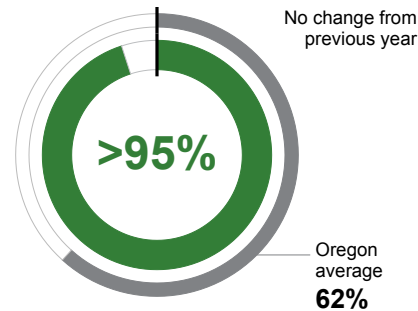
CLASS SIZE

REGULAR ATTENDERS

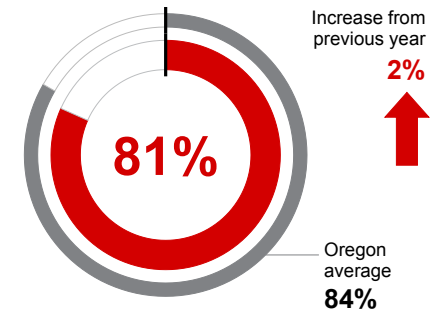

ON-TRACK TO GRADUATE

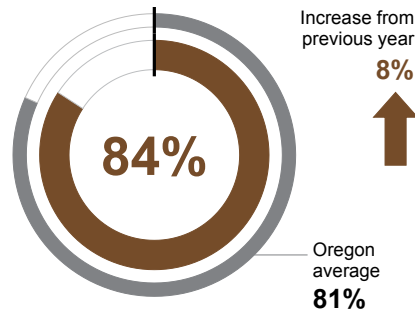
Students earning one-quarter of graduation credits in their 9th grade year.

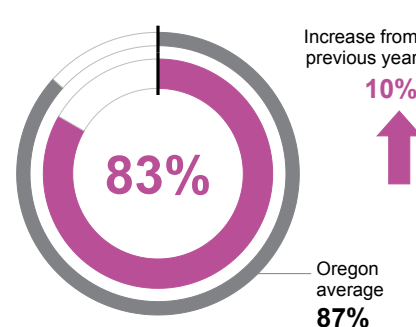
ON-TIME GRADUATION

Students earning a diploma within four years. Cohort includes students who were first-time ninth graders in 2018-19 graduating in 2021-22.



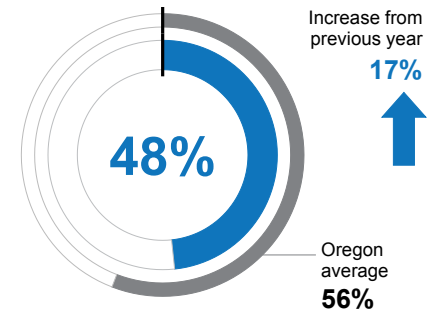
FIVE-YEAR COMPLETION

School Goals

Our primary school goal is to maintain a high number of students who graduate on time. To support this goal, our school counselor and our teachers focus on two areas: freshmen on track and credit recovery. We offer summer school as an option for students who need to recover credits and for 8th grade students and high school students who want to work ahead on credits. Summer school has significantly increased our overall graduation rate.

State Goals

The Oregon Department of Education is partnering with school districts and local communities to ensure a 90% on-time, four year graduation rate by 2027. To progress toward this goal, the state will prioritize efforts to improve attendance, provide a well-rounded education, invest in implementing culturally responsive practices, and promote continuous improvement to close opportunity and achievement gaps for historically and currently underserved students.

Safe & Welcoming Environment

We welcome students from all backgrounds, regardless of what they have previously achieved in education. Our school is a safe place for students who seek or need an alternative method of education. We serve many students who were not successful in a brick-and-mortar environment and need a different location, pace, or curriculum. We welcome homeschool families and students who think about education a little bit differently.

About Our School

ADVANCED COURSEWORK

We offer the following advanced courses through our online curriculum: AP World History, AP Human Geography, AP Language and Composition, and AP Environmental Science. Students are also able to take advanced courses at their local community college through our early college program.

CAREER & TECHNICAL EDUCATION

We have three CTE Programs of Study at SHAPA: Business Marketing, Health Sciences, and Education & Training. Within these programs, students have access to several CTE courses and career opportunities. Students also have opportunities to gain work experience through these programs. We have opened the Sheridan AllPrep Children's Center, a place to provide childcare for local residents and for CTE students to gain hands-on experience in the field of Education & Training. In addition to our formal Programs of Study, we have standalone CTE courses for career exploration in the fields of Human Resources, Information Technology, Business Management, and Visual Arts.

EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Every year, we have four field trips (either virtual or in-person) to OMSI in which both students and parents have the opportunity to participate. We also schedule field trips to one or more of the following locations: The Portland Art Museum; The Evergreen Aviation and Space Museum; Outdoor School at Camp Hancock in Fossil, Oregon or the Coastal Discovery Center in Newport, Oregon; and the Oregon Zoo. In the past, our students have also had the opportunity for international travel education experiences in Greece, Costa Rica, and Peru, and for domestic educational travel on an East Coast Tour. We will continue to host both domestic and international tours.

PARENT & COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT

In an online school, we rely on our parents to be the primary learning coaches for our students. We meet with parents regularly to help them support their students and provide appropriate resources, including curriculum. Although we have limited face to face contact, we encourage our families to be involved in the education process and often see parents and grandparents at our field trips and other school events. Sheridan AllPrep Academy participates in community events and is a member of the local Chamber of Commerce. Since 2021, SHAPA has participated in Sheridan Hometown Days, an annual community event. We engage our extended community through school board meetings, virtual open house events, and other virtual events.
